**It is important to be on time so that no learning time is missed.**



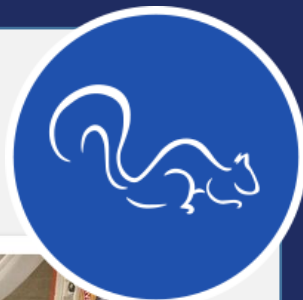


Then you will hang your coat in the cloakroom.
