very smart.



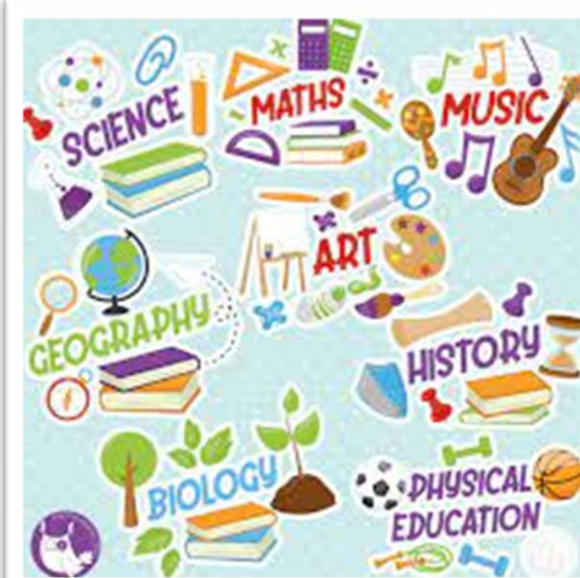
**Welcome to Year 1 and

Miss Lucas will be your teacher in Pinecones.

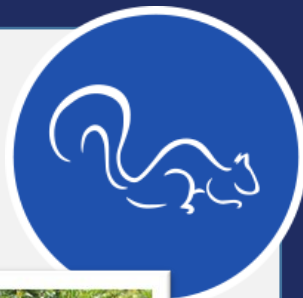

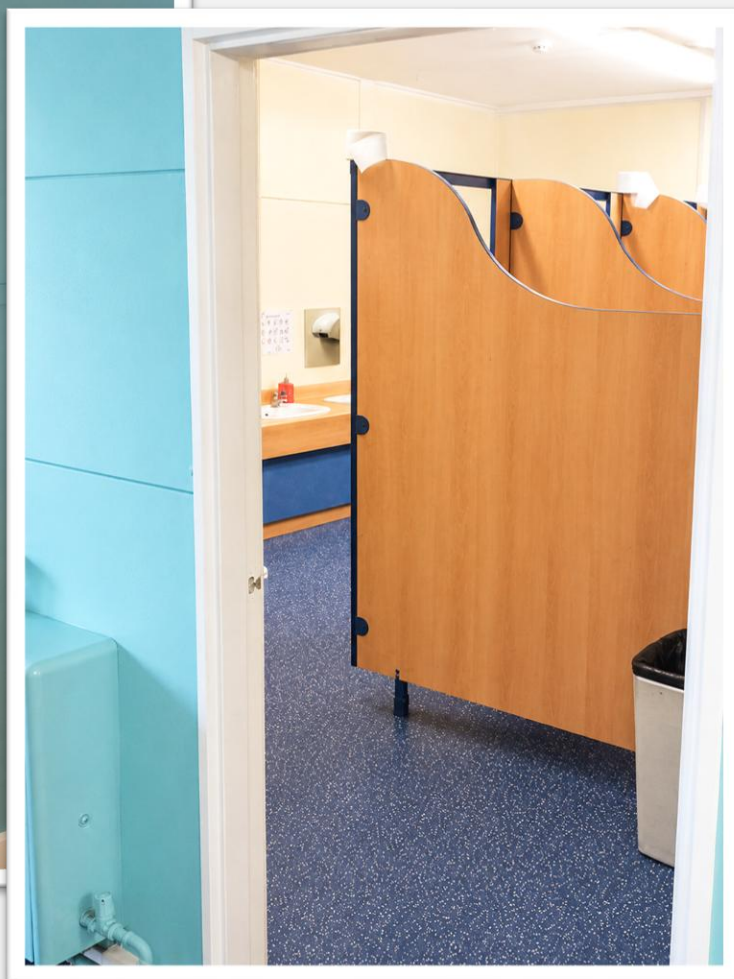
This is the cloakroom where you will hang your coat and bags in the morning.
