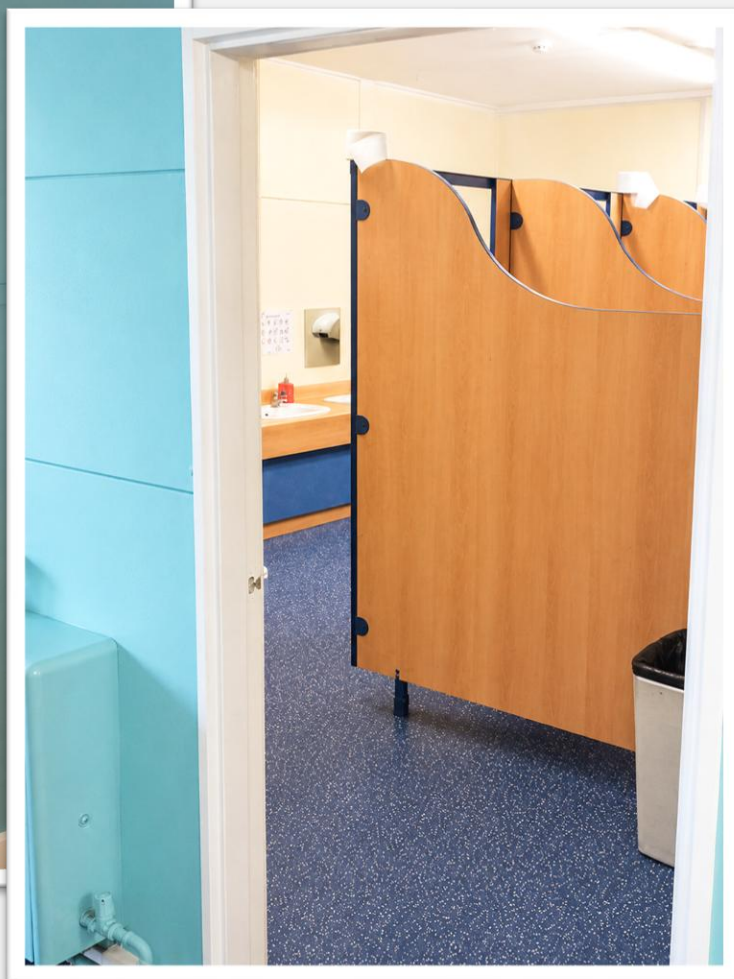
This is the cloakroom where you will hang your coat and bags in the morning.
